4. Principal's Report

- Current school population is 486. Continue to gain and lose children. Overall, are about where we started at the beginning of the year. Seen significant enrolment from newcomers and grade one English.
- This past month hired Mrs. Amanda Eckford who will be taking over grade one Pallister.
 Mrs. Pallister will be going on maternity leave December 21st. Mme. Barbara Webber has
 announced her retirement and her last day will also be December 21st. Mme. Little will be
 coming back from her maternity leave and moving into grade 2W.
- The Purdy's fundraiser was very successful and estimate a profit close to \$6000. We
 continue to support student field trips and opportunities with this money. Two recent
 examples include: paying for a movie, snack and transportation for grade ones, paying for
 skating transportation for all grade 3s. We plan to support swimming for our grade 2s in the
 spring.

- The division's key goal areas focus on the following: learner centred, assessment is instruction, tasks are meaningful, competency and knowledge are taught, embed socialemotional learning. School goals focus on literacy, French Immersion, Indigenous Academic Achievement, Numeracy and Sustainable Development.
